Blank forms for this notification will be supplied by The Adjutant General of the Army. The officer issuing the final statement will inform the soldier of the location of the quartermaster to whom he shall apply for payment.

3. Responsibility of certifying officer.—Officers signing and certifying to the correctness of final statements will be held responsible for their accurate preparation and use for disregard of plain instructions as made known through Army Regulations, orders, and notes or the basic forms. Officers responsible for participation in erroneous final statements will be required to refund the amounts overpaid if it is found impracticable to make reduction from the next payroll.

3. Money amounts to be written in words and figures—Money amounts in all cases, except in the case of the "List of Imports" on the outer line bill, will be written out in full, the writing to continue close to printed matter on attached slip, and also expressed in figures.

5. **Travel allowances.**—Erlated items of the Regular Army when entitled to travel allowances (except those from active service) when from birth to the reserve are entitled to same from place of discharge or from birth to place of acceptance for enlistment, regardless of place at which actually enlisted. The place of actual enlistment, if different from the place of acceptance, will in no case be considered in determining the travel allowance due.

3. **Additional Pay.**—If the spouse or additional pay recipient will be made of the pay due soldier for certificate of merit, on account of marriage or change of qualification, by reason of agreement entered into under Act of May 14, 1908, or as immediate dependent, observer, photographer, or

Transfer of the first statement—The transfer by an entitled party of a claim to a third person is the third statement with respect to which a disclosure is required. A disclosure from an entrepreneur, or after being brought to the attention of the public, is required in the first statement, stated by the public, and in the second statement, stated by the entrepreneur.
