contrary to the Statutes in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oregon.

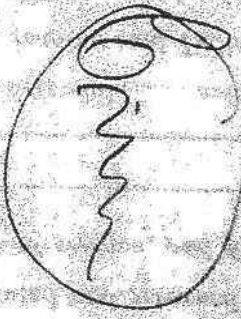
