Know all Men by these Presents:

held and firmly bound unto the People of the State of Illinois, for the use of Lorian Corke
and William Corke

in the penal sum of Twelve hundred

Dollars, current money of the United States, which payment, well and truly to be made and performed, we and each of us
do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, jointly, severally and firmly, by these presents.

Witness our hands and seals this 16th day of Dec A. D. 1865

The Condition of this Obligation is such, That if the above bounden Jesse Corke

who has been appointed Guardian for William Corke and
Lorian Corke

shall faithfully discharge the office and trust of such Guardian according to law, and shall render a fair and just account of
his Guardianship to the County Court of the County of Kendall from time to time, as
he shall be thereto required by said Court, and comply with all the orders of said Court, lawfully made, relative to
the goods, chattels and moneys of such minor and render and pay to such minor \$ all moneys, goods and chattels, title
papers and effects, which may come to the hands and possession of such Guardian belonging to such minor \$ when such
minor \$ shall be thereto entitled, or to any subsequent Guardian \$ should such Court so direct, then this obligation shall be
void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

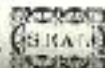
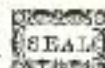
