But is hereby specially provided and declared that my said Executors shall be bound in fulfillment of my intentions contained in the forsaid Free Church Settlement to Assign and Transfer the forsaid Twenty six shares of said British Guiana Bank Stock in favor of said Reverend George Charles and the other persons named as Trustees in the forsaid Trust Assignment for behoof of said Free Church Congregation at Strachan in terms of and in Trust for the uses and purposes particularly expressed in said Trust Assignment in their favor or in favor of any other Trustees that may be named by me in any other Trust Assignment I may hereafter execute for behoof of said Free Church Congregation. And with these alterations I declare the forsaid General Trust Settlement shall stand of full force and Consent to the Registrars hereof along with said Settlement in the Books of Council and Session or others competent for preservation and Constitution.
